##### Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that Cornwall Council intends to make the above Order in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by traffic over an area of highway being Hessenford Road From The A387 Between Junction West Of Bickham And Bake Lane To East Of Riverside Hessenford for its entire length, and Hessenford Road Hessenford between Hessenford Road From The A387 Between Junction West Of Bickham And Bake Lane To East Of Riverside and the junction for Keveral Lane.
